POLICY: Internship Availability

Effective Date: September 1, 2019

TITLE: Internship Availability

RATIONALE: To ensure a sufficient number of sites are available for appropriate and timely learning experiences for educational programs that specify an internship component.

POLICY/PROCEDURE:

The Advisory Board and the Education Director will perform an annual review of the total number of available internship sites against the number of students enrolled in programs that have a clinical internship specification toward course completion.

The Advisory Board and the Education Director will evaluate the total call volume for EMS Agencies along with the types of calls to ensure adequacy of student opportunities toward the clinical goals of the experience. Based on this evaluation, the Board and Director may choose to keep an EMS agency on the active list for student internship, or choose to remove it until further notice.

Hospital internships will be evaluated for efficacy based on the critical care rating level of the facility and the adequacy of student opportunities as identified. As with EMS agencies, the board may choose to keep a hospital on the active list for student internships or choose to remove it until further notice.

The Advisory Board and Education Director will also consider the student satisfaction surveys that are submitted for each rotation to help guide decisions on both EMS agencies and Hospitals.
