POLICY: E-learning Student Identity for Integrity

Effective Date: September 1, 2019

TITLE: E-learning Student Identity & Integrity

RATIONALE: To assure the identity of students engaged in e-learning coursework for the integrity of the curriculum.

POLICY/PROCEDURE:

All coursework provided through the use of online “E-Learning” instruction shall maintain the following safeguards to ensure student identity and the integrity of his/her work:

Students for online “e-learning” education will be granted access to the learning management system (LMS) via email invitation. The email invitation will ONLY be sent to the email addressed provided upon course registration.

The email invitation will require the student to create a unique password upon entry into the online classroom.

To improve the integrity of the curriculum, all summative assessments provided through the LMS will be delivered in:

- Randomized order
- No backtracking allowed
- One question per page delivery
